

Congratulations - It's your turn!!

This week your game will be played inside the State Netball Centre.

Please make sure all your supporters and team officials are made aware of the following information.

To ensure you have the best experience possible, there are some things you need to know.

- The only thing that is changing this week is your court location. Everything else relating to the game is the same.
 - You pick up your score card from the PNA Match Day Office.
 - The match rules are the same.
 - The winning team returns the score card to the PNA Match Day Office.

- Inside the State Netball Centre, there are some special requirements in place to protect and maintain the standard of the venue.
 - You enter the State Netball Centre via the front doors in the glass foyer area.
 - There are absolutely no heeled shoes permitted on the timber flooring - soft shoes only.
 - You can warm up on the court you are playing on, after the previous game has finished. If there is a spare court, please do not use it as it has not been booked for PNA. There is room outside to warm up on before you go inside.
 - The players, team officials, scorer and umpire are permitted in the middle of the courts. They are to use the seating provided. Only umpires and umpire coaches (if applicable) are permitted to stand around the court.
 - All other patrons watch the game from the comfy blue seats in the grandstand.
 - The scoring is on the PNA score card – not the electronic system courtside.
 - Whilst we encourage refreshments at break times, only water is permitted in the timber floor area. Oranges and other refreshments can be consumed in the grandstand area or just outside the court area in the foyer.
