### DIVISION C

**TIMES:** Saturday Mornings – 8:30-10:30

**VENUES:** School Ovals

**TEAM:** 8 players per team. More players can play if teams have extra numbers.

**YEAR LEVELS:** 4/5

**DRAW:** My Cricket website - [www.wspsc.sa.cricket.com.au](http://www.wspsc.sa.cricket.com.au)

**PITCH LENGTH:** 16m Approx.

**OVERS:** 32 overs per game. Each side bats for 16 overs. 6 balls per over only.

**WIDES & NO BALLS:** Wides are balls that are deemed unreachable by the batter. No balls are given for waist high or above full tosses, balls that bounce over the batters head or by a bowler over stepping the crease on delivery. 2 runs are awarded to the batting team for every wide & no ball. Wides and No Balls are NOT re-bowled.

**BALL:** Kookaburra super soft a ball or incredi ball

**EQUIPMENT:** Pads, gloves, protectors, bats, gloves. All batters & the wicketkeeper must wear helmets.

**BOUNDARY:** 30 meters approximately (to be marked with cones by home team)

**BATTING:** Batters bat in pairs for 4 overs each.

**BOWLING:** Each player bowls 2 overs each.

**FIELDING:** No fielders are allowed within 10 meters of the batter except for fielders in slips, gully and the wicketkeeper. 3 fielders on each side of the pitch at all times.

#### GENERAL OVERVIEW

- Fielding team must have a bowler, a wicketkeeper, 3 fielders on both side at all times.
- The 16 over's for the fielding team are bowled in two 8 over blocks.
- Eg: Bowl 8 over's from one end and then swap to bowl 8 over's from the other end.
- Each time the batter gets out they swap ends.

**SCORING SYSTEM:** Teams begin the match with 200 runs each and runs are added to the total with each wicket lost meaning 5 runs are added to the opposition's team total score.

Example: 100 runs scored & 10 wickets lost =

Score: 200 + 100 (runs scored) = 300 + 50 (10 wickets taken) = **350 total score**
