Week 8 & 9 LEARNING INTENTIONS

For the Children to:

Emotional

- * Let someone know when they are feeling sad.
- * Stay calm when things don't go to plan.

Social

- * Enter a conversation appropriately.
- * Engage in conversation during play.

Language

- * Repeat and practise Italian phrases and gestures - uno, due, tre, occhi a me, quattro, cinque, sei, occhi a te. (Week 8) Ripetete insieme (Week 9)
- * Identify how language is used differently at home and school depending on the relationships between people.
- * Know what they are going to say before raising their hand.

Cognitive

- * Identify and share stories to do with their own cultural background.
- * Recognise and respect all cultures.

Physical

- *Practise safe hygiene habits.
- *Pack, tidy, clean all indoor and outdoor areas.

Literacy

- *Practise the graph /s/ and /u/ as in 'sun' (Week 8) and the graph /n/ and /e/ as in 'net' (Week 9).
- *Identify common words 'was', 'up', 'but', 'not' (Week 8), 'I', 'went', 'to', 'get' (Week 9).
- *Notice and talk about the important information in a text.
- *Infer the feelings of characters in stories.
- *Create drawings that employ careful attention to colour or detail.
- *Write and draw about one idea on a page.

Numeracy

- *Connect number names, numerals and quantities, including zero, up to 8.
- *Sort, describe and name 2D shapes in the environment.

Religion

- *Retell the events of Holy Week.
