

BEHAVIOUR CONTINUUM



Minors

Non-compliance failing to follow instructions.

Disruption interrupting learning through backchat, calling out and interrupting.

Incomplete work due to refusal and time wasting.

Unsafe behaviour such as running indoors, rocking on chairs and throwing objects that could harm others.

Unkind words name calling.

Taking other people's possessions removing items from the learning space, taking hats, kicking away people's equipment.

Misuse of equipment scribbling on others work, using equipment not for it's intended purpose.

Out of Bounds playing in restricted areas.

Possession of prohibited items such as gum, aerosol cans roller and spray lollies.

Majors

Swearing or offensive language not directed towards anyone

Physical contact touching another person with or without harm

Threatening behaviour threatening to harm someone or their property

Misuse of technology a breach of the ICT agreement

Damaging property vandalising or damaging property of others or harming the environment.

Leaving the learning space walking out of the class without permission.

Theft intentionally taking and keeping someone else's belongings.

Repeated Minor behaviours persistent refusal to comply with school values.

Executive

Swearing or offensive language directed towards someone including racism, sexism, homophobia or religious discrimination.

Directed physical contact deliberate actions involving serious physical contact.

Extreme damage to school property or resources damaging ICT, destruction of learning spaces or throwing furniture.

Leaving the school grounds without being dismissed.

Bullying ongoing, targeted with intention to harm physically, verbally or cyber, including rumour spreading.

Sexualised Behaviour concerning behaviours for the age of the student.

Illicit substances the possession and/or use of illegal or pharmaceutical drugs or alcohol.

Possession of a weapon with or without intent to cause harm.

Using your phone or smart watch from drop off to pick up inside the school grounds

Repeated Major Behaviours persistent refusal to comply with school values.

| Behaviours | Definition | Consequence |

| Non-Compliance | Failing to follow instructions. | Classroom-Steps Yard- walk with the teacher. |
| Disruption | Interrupting learning through backchat, calling out and interrupting. | Classroom-Steps |
| Incomplete Work | Incomplete work due to refusal and time wasting. | Classroom-Steps or stay in and complete work. |
| Unsafe Behaviour | Such as running indoors, rocking on chairs and throwing sand. | Classroom-Steps Yard- walk with the teacher. |
| Unkind Words | Name calling. | Classroom-Steps Yard- walk with the teacher. |
| Taking other people's possessions | Removing items from the learning space, taking hats, kicking away people's equipment. | Classroom-Steps Yard- walk with the teacher. |
| Misuse of Equipment | Misuse of equipment scribbling on others work, using equipment not for it's intended purpose. | Classroom-Steps Yard- walk with the teacher. |
| Out of Bounds | Out of Bounds playing in restricted areas. | Yard- Walk with the teacher. |
| Possession of Prohibited items | Such as gum, aerosol cans, roller and spray lollies. | Item confiscated until 3:30. |

Major Behaviours

| Behaviours | Definition | Consequence |
|--------------------------------|--|--|
| Swearing or offensive language | Not directed toward anyone | Classroom-Step 4 removal Yard- Reflection room for 3 lunches |
| Physical contact | Touching another person with or without harm. | Classroom-Step 4 removal Yard- Reflection room for 5 lunches |
| Threatening behaviour | Threatening to harm someone or their property. | Classroom-Step 4 removal Yard- Reflection room for 5 lunches |
| Misuse of technology | Breach of the ICT agreement | Classroom- banned from using ICT for at least a week. |
| Damaging property | Vandalising or damaging property of others or harming the environment. | Classroom-Step 4 removal Yard- Reflection room for 3 lunches and cleaning or repairing of the item. |
| Leaving the learning space | Walking out of the class without permission | Classroom- Step 4 removal and 2 lunches in the reflection room |
| Theft | Intentionally taking and keeping someone else's belongings. | Classroom- Step 4 removal. Yard- Reflection room for 3 lunches. |
| Repeated Minor Behaviours | Persistent refusal to comply with school values | Classroom- BSP and parent meeting. Yard- BSP and parent meeting |

Extreme Behaviours

| Behaviours | Definition | Consequence |
|--|---|--|
| Swearing or offensive language | directed towards someone including racism, sexism, homophobia or religious discrimination. | Suspension |
| Directed physical contact | deliberate actions involving serious physical contact. | Suspension |
| Extreme damage to school property or resources | damaging ICT, destruction of learning spaces or throwing furniture. | Suspension, banned from using devices and replacement or repair of property. |
| Leaving school grounds | Walking off the school grounds without being dismissed. | Suspension |
| Bullying | Ongoing, targeted with intention to harm physically, verbally or cyber, including rumour spreading. | Suspension |
| Sexualised Behaviour | concerning behaviours for the age of the student. | Leadership discretion. |
| Illicit substances | the possession and/or use of illegal or pharmaceutical drugs or alcohol. | Suspension |
| Possession of a weapon | with or without intent to cause harm. | Suspension |
| Using phone or smart watch | From drop off to pick up inside the school grounds | After school detention |
| Repeated Major Behaviours | persistent refusal to comply with school values. | Classroom- BSP and parent meeting. Yard- BSP and parent meeting and possibly suspension |
