This program provides:

Program outcomes include:

- Students make informed career choices to access Vocational Education and Training (VET) options
- Students develop individual learning plans identifying courses and study options linked to their preferred careers

Students will develop skills and knowledge in:

- · Work health and safety in a workshop environment
- How to safely use and maintain tools and equipment
- Using tools like brakes, presses, and rollers
- · Introduction into project planning
- Measuring and cutting metal
- · Basic welding skills
- Introduction to shielded metal arc welding
- Metal forming techniques, such as bending, rolling, and shaping metal Exploring various methods of joining metal, such as riveting, bolting, and adhesives

Participant eligibility

Participants must be:

- A minimum 15 years of age
- attending EPP school
- likely to benefit from exposure to a vocational pathway
