



Road Management Plan 2021

Have your say!

In accordance with the Road Management Act, Darebin City Council proposes to amend its Road Management Plan and is ready for you to take a look.

The Road Management Plan outlines the principles, methods and systems used in managing Darebin's road network. The plan includes:

- Details the road management function under the control of Council.
- Set the relevant standards of how Council carries out road management function.
- Sets the standards based on policy and operation objectives within the resources available.
- Ensures the provision of a safe

and efficient road network for users and the community.

- Minimises road safety hazards and disruption to traffic.

In summary, the internal review has proposed the following minor changes:

- Administrative changes to make the Road Management Plan easier to read.
- Inspection changes where officers will inspect bike lanes concurrently with other parts of the road assets.
- The addition of emergency works being carried out within 36 hours (e.g. flooding).
- Inspections including inspections for tree obstructions from private and Council owned trees being added to the plan.
