Epping Secondary College offers scholarship opportunities to students who have displayed outstanding attributes whilst at school and possess personal qualities and values that will contribute positively to the life of the College.

Scholarship recipients are expected to further excel and develop their skills during their time at Epping Secondary College.

2023 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Epping Secondary College offers a range of Scholarships in the following areas:

Primary School Dux

One scholarship will be made available for each feeder primary school. Eligibility for the scholarship will be reliant upon a student being named the 'Dux' by their primary school. This scholarship will be to the value of \$300 per year whilst the student remains at Epping Secondary College.

Academic

3 Academic scholarships (\$200) will be awarded for 2023, one at Year 7/8, one at Year 9/10 and one at Year 11/12. Academic scholarships are awarded for two years to students who demonstrate strong academic performance (achievement & growth), positively demonstrate College values and participation in a range of academic opportunities within and beyond school.

Sporting

3 Sporting scholarships (\$200) will be awarded for 2023, one at Year 7/8, one at Year 9/10 and one at Year 11/12. Sporting scholarships are awarded for two years to students who demonstrate strong ability in sport, positively demonstrate College values and participation in sport both within & beyond school.

The Arts

3 Arts scholarships (\$200) will be awarded for 2023, one at Year 7/8, one at Year 9/10 and one at Year 11/12. Arts scholarships are awarded for two years to students who demonstrate strong abilities in an area of The Arts, positively demonstrate College values and participation in artistic endeavour both within & beyond school.

Community Citizenship

3 Community Citizenship scholarships (\$200) will be awarded for 2023, one at Year 7/8, one at Year 9/10 and one at Year 11/12. Community Citizenship scholarships are awarded for two years to students who demonstrate good citizenship through their involvement in all aspects of school life. This could include involvement in student leadership, extra curricular activities and volunteer efforts across the College.

Application

Applications for all scholarships are now open and can be submitted online by following the link detailed below.

In submitting an application, students will be asked to provide supporting documentation that will include:

- their most recent end of semester school report.
- evidence of their achievements to support their application.
- a written reference from a current teacher.
- any supporting documents to substantiate involvement in activities beyond school.

Applications for all scholarships will close on Friday 18th November 2022 at 2:00pm. No late applications will be accepted.

Selection

Selection for all scholarships is based on written application and may also involve an interview for short listed candidates.

Scholarship Information

Applicants for all scholarships must have an excellent academic and behavioural record. In addition to scholarship specific requirements, all applicants must be able to demonstrate at interview and by written application, that they possess personal qualities and values which will contribute significantly to the life of our College.

The College will only award scholarships, if the applicant is of the highest standard.

Families are reminded that it is not possible to award a scholarship to every worthy applicant and will abide by the final decision of the College.

Scholarship recipients will be monitored by the College. Poor performance by a scholarship student may result in a scholarship being cancelled.
