This nationally recognized qualification is from the AHC Agriculture, Horticulture, Conservation and Land Management Training Package.

Completing this qualification in part or in its entirety at CERES Community Environment Park provides students with a range of skills and units that are transferable to further study or a career in horticulture.

Students are involved in the full garden cycle from planting the seed to harvesting the crops and building and landscaping projects. They learn a range of horticulture skills such as propagation, planting, pruning trees and shrubs, landscaping and plant and weed identification whilst working in our 4.5 hectare urban farm in East Brunswick.
