Creating an ATAR Portal account:

This is separate to your QTAC application – it's how you find out your ATAR

Opens 1 August: ATAR | QTAC

 - Suggestion: create an account that serves as your tertiary email business, eg
 QTAC, then tertiary student, even applying for internships, casual work and graduate positions
 - If you use an existing email account Suggestion: set up a folder QTAC and a rule to send all QTAC emails to one place

Adjustment factors and bonus ranks:

They are automatically applied for subjects that meet the institution's criteria and each institution has a maximum that can apply.

For example:

- LOTE
- Specialist Maths
- Each institution has statements online about what they accept for bonus ranks
- Clayfield as a partner school with ACU

Pro tip: check each of your institutions in your preferences for what adjustment factors they accept
