

The way you get to and from school is changing

What's happening

Construction activities to remove the level crossings at Glen Huntly Road and Neerim Road will take place 24-hours-a-day from the **29 May until late July 2023**. This means that both the level crossings will be closed to drivers and pedestrians.

Pedestrians

When travelling to and from St. Anthony's from Neerim Road and Glen Huntly Road

Pedestrian and footpath access to the area will be maintained with local detours in place.

Detours will be clearly signposted and temporary fencing and concrete barriers will separate the works area and keep pedestrians safe.

Glen Huntly Road will be closed to vehicles between James Street and Grange Road, but pedestrians will still be able to use the footpaths to visit the local shops. There will be NO pedestrian access across the level crossing.

The Neerim Road level crossing will be closed, with no pedestrian access between Watson Grove and Heath Drive, and across the level crossing.

Please note that Queens Avenue will be closed to pedestrians.



Drivers

If you usually drive through Glen Huntly to get to St Anthony's, you will be detoured while these major works take place.

Glen Huntly Road will be closed to vehicles between Booran Road and Grange Road until mid-July.

Neerim Road will be closed to vehicles between Booran Road and Grange Road until late June. The level crossing will also be closed, with no pedestrian access between Watson Grove and Heath Drive, and across the level crossing.

Please take care when driving around construction zones and follow the detour signage and any instructions from traffic control staff.



Using the community shuttle to get to school

To help keep you moving during the works, you can travel on the Yarra Trams replacement bus for free. The bus will connect you to both sides of Glen Huntly Road and Neerim Road. Simply board the bus at one of the Yarra Trams' replacement bus stops on Glen Huntly Road (see map).

If you are using the free community shuttle to get to school, get on the bus heading away from the city at the corner of Booran Road and Glen Huntly Road. The bus will then drop students at the corner of Grange Road and Glen Huntly Road on the other side of the level crossing closure.

The bus stop for the return journey can be found at the corner of Watson Grove and Grange Road.

Please note that the shuttle bus will NOT stop outside the school. At this stage a separate bus will not be provided for the school.

The community shuttle is expected to take approximately 20 minutes. Please allow sufficient time for students to travel on the shuttle to school to allow for school start and finish times.

It will operate every 12 minutes in peak hours and every 20 minutes outside of peak hours.

Please reassure your children that we understand they may be late to school due to these changed travel arrangements.

Community Shuttle Bus



PTV Bus Route

From late May to late June, passengers on the **PTV route 623** and **route 624 bus services** will be detoured while Neerim Road is closed.

On the detoured sections, buses will only stop at the following stops:

- PTV 623: Kambrook Road/Glen Eira Road, Maroona Road/Neerim Road and Milton Street/Neerim Road
- PTV 624: Caulfield Station/Sir John Monash Drive, Maroona Road/Neerim Road, and Milton Street/Neerim Road
