



HOW DOES THE SCORING SYSTEM WORK?

- The scoring system in volleyball is a points-based system. In rally scoring, a point is granted to the winning team of the given rally, or sequence of plays that begins with a serve and ends with a point. This is played up to 25 points with a two-point margin of victory.

WHAT ARE SOME BASICS RULES IN VOLLEYBALL?

- 6 players on a team- 3 front row and 3 back row
- Maximum of 3 hits per side
- Player may not hit the ball twice in succession
- Ball may be played off the net during a volley and on serve
- A ball hitting a boundary line is "in"
- It is illegal to catch, hold or throw the ball
