








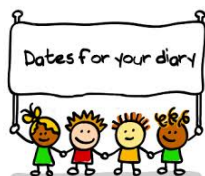

<p>RELIGION</p> 	<p><u>TOPIC: 'Caring for our Common Home'</u></p> <p>Throughout this term the Year 2s will explore God's Wonderful World. They will get the opportunity to unpack what makes God's world so wonderful, issues the world is facing and pledge to make sure we do everything in our power to look after it. In addition, we will make connections with our local community and look at how we can care for God's Wonderful World in our backyard. Students will also be exposed to Laudato Si, an encyclical written by Pope Francis explaining what people have done to damage our environment and how we can come together to save it. Finally, students will look at how we see God in our community.</p>	

<p>SPELLING</p>   <p>Recording: Morphology & Etymology Workshop</p>	<p>This term in spelling students will revise sounds introduced to them in Year One as well as become exposed to a range of new sounds. These are the sounds that we will be looking at:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Short A Review, Short I Review, Short O Review • FLSZ Rule (ff, ll, ss, zz) • -all, -oll, -ull • vowel, constant, vowel (e_e) • -es • -ed • -ing • Closed and open syllables • Closed and closed syllables • Diagraph review
<p>LITERACY (Reading/Writing)</p> 	<p>Students will explore the English language through two key areas this term. The first area explored will be Uluru and Indigenous Cultures. The second will be through the text 'The Little Prince'. These topics will enable students to develop a more comprehensive understanding of the English language. Students will explore the differences between sentences and fragments, grammar (verbs, adjectives, nouns, adverbs) and punctuation.</p>
<p>MATHEMATICS</p> 	<p>Throughout this term, three key mathematical topics will be explored. Students will work their way through units of Place Value, Time, Addition and Subtraction. Year 2s will use a variety of different concrete materials to help explore these concepts. They will also be exposed to multiple different strategies for problem-solving.</p>
<p>KNOWLEDGE BASED/ INQUIRY</p> 	<p>Our focus in Inquiry this term is Geography. Students will explore our local community, what makes a community, who is part of the community and how a community works. We will begin by looking at Australia as a community and then work our way down until we reach our local community of Holy Family. Students will have many opportunities to explore, discuss and create in this unit.</p>
