RELIGION



TOPIC: Looking after God's Home

Students will be encouraged to make connections between God's plan for people to live safely and happily and what is illustrated by Jesus' teaching and their personal experience (e.g. at school, home, community) Students will explore their feelings and thoughts about societal laws (e.g. classroom, playground, family, safety) and how these laws are intended for the good of all, rather than to meet individual wants and needs.

LITERACY



In Literacy students will continue to explore the book "Ella Kazoo will not brush her hair" by Fox and Willcox. They will be learning about the characters, setting, problem and solution and also exploring words that rhyme. This week we will focus on handwriting and learning the sound for the letter 'r' as in 'Roxy the rabbit'. Please use this LINK to help your child practise the LLLL Speed Sounds & Chants at home. This will show you the way that we learn the sounds of the alphabet and also reinforce your child's learning at school.

HOME DECODABLE BOOKS

Students will receive a new Decodable Book to bring home at the beginning of each week. Your child should be practising to read the same book at home every day. Before reading, revise the Speed sounds and the Heart words that can be found at the back of each book. Following this, you can:

Talk about the book



Look at the front cover and:

- Ask your child to read the title out loud, tracking their finger under each word as they read it.
- Introduce the characters your child will meet in the book
- Explore the illustrations. For example, ask: Can you point to the map?

During reading

Read and enjoy the book

- Ask your child to read out loud, tracking their finger under each word as they read
- Support your child if they are stuck by asking them to sound out and then blend the sounds together to read the word. When they have decoded the word, go back and re-read the sentence together.

After reading

Ask some of the "Questions to talk about" which can also be found at the back of each book. See if your child is able to recall some of the characters and/or key events.

MATHS



During Maths students will be investigating 2D shapes for the next two weeks. They will sort shapes into groups based on their different features, such as the number of sides, colour or size. They will learn to name and simply describe the following 2D shapes-*rectangles, squares, triangles, circles* and find these familiar shapes within the environment.

INQUIRY

TOPIC: 'Making Healthy and Safe Choices'

Students are exploring how they can be safe and healthy. This week students will learn more about making good social choices at home and school. They



will also learn ways to make good choices with food such as reading symbols on food packaging.

SCHOOL UNIFORM
