ABC MUSIC INSTRUMENTAL PROGRAMS

KEYBOARD & GUITAR PROGRAMS

The students will attend small group lessons for 30 min weekly during school hours. Group lessons allow students of varying abilities to play together as an ensemble/ band and gain valuable music skills of rhythm, timing and melody. Playing a musical instrument is one of the activities that is learned and enjoyed better in a group environment, builds self-esteem, team work and encourages children to progress as their friends and form "their own band"

- 1- Groups of 4 students fees are \$139 per term
- 2- Paired Lessons (2 students per group) fees are \$249 per term

Keyboard and Guitar rentals start from \$7.00 per month

STRING PROGRAMS

For **Violin lessons** students can attend group lessons (of 2 students) for 30 min weekly during school hours. Fees are \$250 per term for paired group lessons. *We offer FREE Rental for Violin

BAND PROGRAMS

Band instruments include **Clarinet**, **Flute**, **Alto Saxophone**, **and Trumpet**. The students attend small group lessons (up to 2 students) each week for 30min. *Fees per term \$250*. These instruments are suitable to grade 2 – 6 students. In addition to the lessons students attend the free weekly rehearsal, which runs on the same day as the lessons. *We offer FREE Rental for woodwind/brass students. Private lessons are also available and cost \$40 per 30min lesson

ABC MUSIC TEACHERS

All of our teachers hold a University Degree or Diploma in their field and also hold WWCC and all covered under Work Cover, Public Liability and Superannuation. As for correspondence with the parents, we have dedicated staff in our office that handle both emails and phone calls in a timely manner and ensure that all matters are dealt with promptly and professionally. FORMAL REPORTS and EXAMS (AMEB, ANZCA)

We hand out reports twice a year in terms 2 and 4 so that the parents are able to keep up to date with the progress of their child and see what areas they could help with at home such a practice. Furthermore we offer formal exams to the students who are keen to work toward a goal. Our teachers work closely with the students making sure they are prepared and achieve great results in theory and practise outcomes.
