





On arriving at school, all students will place bags along the walls adjacent to buildings under the blue shade sail. Teachers will be there to help direct. We ask students to arrive at 8:30am.

Students are to gather in their own classroom **as soon as luggage has been dropped off.**

On the first day of camp, it is required that students bring their own morning snack and lunch. This can be brought in a small backpack. **Chewing gum or lollies are not to be brought to camp.**

Students may also bring a book or a small game such as a deck of cards if they wish but **no electronics (cameras, phones, smart watches, iPads etc).** A small favourite soft toy can also be brought from home.

Arrabri Lodge provides a blanket on each bed- students need to bring their OWN pillow, pillow slip, fitted sheet, sleeping bag, towel and toiletries (no spray deodorant). Under NO circumstances are campers permitted to use existing Arrabri bed covers and pillow slips as their own bedding whilst on camp (see list on next page).

Medical Organisation:

Any parent needing to hand in medicine will need to do so at the designated table at the front entrance to the office. Miss King will be waiting for you. A medicine administration form has been sent to all parents who have indicated through the Operoo camp form, that their child will need medication administered while away on camp. If you did not complete this, and your child will need medication while away, please email eking@hfmw.catholic.edu.au as soon as possible.

All medicine must be clearly labelled with your child's name in either a snap lock bag or other suitable container. Parents must hand in all medicine. Students are not to hand medicine in, nor should students have any medication in their bags.

Teachers will carry Epi-pens, asthma puffers etc and other necessary medications for the bus trip, as is usual on all school excursions.
