Competitors have a 5 minute time-slot in which to perform. Penalties will apply if time is exceeded.

Competitors are judged on entertainment value, presentation skills and selection of material. Poems that have won first place in a competition should not be performed by the same poet in future years, in the same competition.

Poems performed may be read, with no penalties applying, however memorised poems tend to score higher.

Judges decisions are final and discussions are not entered into with the entrant or any representatives of the entrant including family.
