## Works alert – Charman Road closure and night works

The Victorian Government is removing 18 dangerous level crossings on the Frankston line, including at Charman Road and Park Road in Cheltenham and at Balcombe Road in Mentone, to improve safety and reduce congestion.

Work to lower the rail line into a trench is ramping up, and activities need to take place in and around the rail corridor to prepare the area for major construction works to start.

### Works taking place

From **2pm on Friday 15 November 2019 until Friday 6 December 2019**, Charman Road will be closed to traffic between Station Road and Blagdon Street (see map over the page).

This is to enable underground cable works and drainage upgrades to take place.

Construction will take place 24 hours a day during this time, so we can keep the road closure to a minimum.

### Temporary road closure

Pedestrian access will be maintained to shops, Cheltenham Primary School, Cheltenham Pioneer Cemetery and over the level crossing while Charman Road is closed to vehicles between Blagdon Street and Station Road (see map over the page).

### What to expect

- Construction activities will take place 24 hours a day during this time
- Workers, vehicles and equipment, with moderate noise from machinery, including excavators
- Traffic management will be in place to help you get around
- Detours maps are provided over the page
