DEAR PARISHIONERS, Congratulations to all the children who celebrated their First Holy Communion this weekend, please continue to keep the children and their families in your prayers!

From this Sunday the 9.00am & 10.45am Mass on Sunday will be live streamed to the parish hall for 35 people with an unknown vaccination status as the DQ4 still applies and Communion will be brought to the hall.

Online bookings to attend weekend or weekday Masses will no longer be necessary. For safety reasons and poor ventilation in the Church, for now we will not be seating parishioners to our full capacity as our previous normal. Seating in the Church will be on a first come, first served basis till we reach a reasonable capacity in the Church. We will not be moving the Church pews for now, please do not move them for your safety. If there is no room in the Church, please stay in the foyer or outside the Church.

The Adoration Chapel is now open. Please check in with the QR Victorian Services App on arrival and follow instructions. You are still required to complete the sign in register also.

MASS ATTENDANCE IN THE CHURCH: online booking to attend Mass is no longer necessary, capacity limits will still apply for now as Casey is still regarded as a hotspot. Church will be limited to 200 people. Please arrive early to Mass as the Church doors will be locked 15 minutes before Mass.

UNKNOWN VACCINATION: Masses will be live streamed on Sunday at 9.00am & 10.45am in Parish Hall and Mass in the Church on Thursday at 7.00pm for 30 unvaccinated in the Hall & 50 in the Church DQ4 rule still applies

FACE COVERINGS: Are recommended if you cannot physically distance.

FUNERALS (INDOOR AND OUTDOOR): Permitted with up to 200 fully vaccinated people indoors. Children under 12 months old are not counted towards this cap. 50 unknown status DQ4 rule applies

Please refrain from touching or kissing devotional items. They should be venerated by bowing or other faith appropriate action.

ADORATION CHAPEL please check in with QR code on arrival and follow instructions. Capacity limits still apply.

SOCIAL DISTANCING: The pews in the Church have been moved for your safety. Please do not move the pews in the Church for your safety and it causes damage to the carpet.
