<u>COVID SAFETY:</u> In line with current government restrictions capacity limit 250 Church & foyer. Wearing of masks indoors is compulsory.

MASS ATTENDANCE: by booking online via the parish website link at https://stagathas.org.au/online-booking-holy-mass.html for weekend Masses. Online bookings act as your reservation. Please arrive early to Mass as the Church doors will be locked 15 minutes before Mass, to get your name checked off the booking list and check in on arrival using the Victorian Government QR code provided for every person entering the Church. Please note: if you choose to come to a weekend Mass without a booking and the Church is at capacity you will NOT be able to enter the Church, you may remain outside and communion will be brought to you. For parishioners who are unable to register a QR code, an iPad stand self-check in, has been set up in the foyer for you to check in.

ADORATION CHAPEL is open for private prayer. You are required to sign in and out in the book provided in the chapel and check in with the QR code. A maximum of **five** attendees from different families can pray together at a time. If you are all members of one family the 5-person limit does not apply. For everyone's safety please abide by the rules.

GROUP LÉADERS: Parish groups meeting return to face-to-face leaders are required to keep a record of all those attending the meeting for 28 days for COVID tracing purposes please ensure your members check in with the QR code set up for your meeting space, masks are compulsory and keep to the 2 sqm rule thank you.
