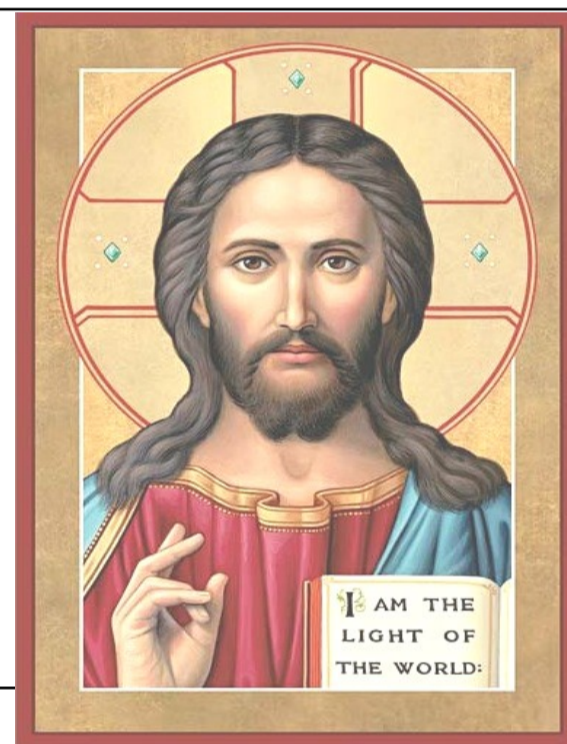

Lenten Penance Obligations

- All who have completed their 18th year and have not yet begun their 60th year are bound to **fast and abstain from meat on Good Friday.**
- All who have completed their 14th year are bound to **abstain from meat** on Good Friday.
- Pastors, teachers, parent are to ensure that even those who, by reason of their age, are not bound by the law of fasting and abstinence from meat, are taught the true meaning of penance.

PASCHAL PRECEPT: Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year, between Ash Wednesday(26 Feb 2020) and Trinity Sunday (7 June 2020).

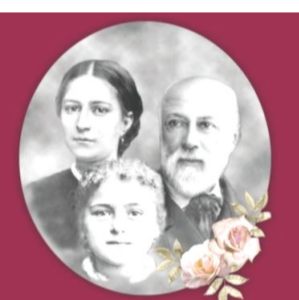

Gospel Reading: A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew
Jesus was led by the Spirit out into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. He fasted for forty days and forty nights, after which he was very hungry, and the tempter came and said to him, 'If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to turn into loaves.' But he replied, 'Scripture says: Man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.' The devil then took him to the holy city and made him stand on the parapet of the Temple. 'If you are the Son of God,' he said, 'throw yourself down; for scripture says: He will put you in his angels' charge, and they will support you on their hands in case you hurt your foot against a stone.' Jesus said to him, 'Scripture also says: You must not put the Lord your God to the test.' YOUNG CARMELITE COMET, "LIT UP THE WHOLE CHURCH"

Theresian Scholar, **Bishop Gaucher** (1930-2014), presents Therese as a women of contradiction and complexity, just 15 when she joined the Order of Discalced Carmelites. Therese suffered from scrupulosity yet had a mystical love for Jesus Christ. Inspired by the Song of Songs, she wrote poems about her love. She was also capable of prodigious love for people, which showed in her kindness for others or in what she called her 'little way'. People asked her to intercede for them with the Divine, and there occurred what many call "the shower of glory", as thousands claimed she came to their aid. She wanted to love Jesus Christ and to inspire others to love him. She did not wish to call down any glory on herself. But glory came calling, beatified in 1923, canonised in 1925 and made a **doctor of the Church in 1997**, being only the third women to do so.
