



IGNATIAN INDUCTION PROGRAM FOR PARENTS

All John XXIII College staff and parents are given the opportunity to participate in the Ignatian Induction Program.

The modules aim to provide staff and parents with the essence of the ethos of John XXIII College. They are a great opportunity to learn about Ignatian Spirituality and meet other parents to explore spirituality within an Ignatian context.

The program consists of six independent content modules with a certificate issued upon completion of all six modules.

While staff complete the units over two full days, parents are offered a more flexible way to complete the modules. The modules are offered to parents in six 1.5 hour sessions that can be completed non-consecutively.
