We are excited to announce that we have planned a fun event for our major fundraiser this year, a Colour Run! This whole school event will take place on the school oval Friday, 18 November at 2:20pm. Parents & Caregivers are welcome to attend. Students will be dismissed from the oval immediately after the event.

The purpose of the event is not only to raise funds for our school but also to enhance a positive spirit. Students will be seeking online sponsorship for their efforts with funds raised contributing to improvements to our outdoor areas. The improvements include the addition of some fun painted games such as 4 square, snakes & ladders & hopscotch which will benefit all current and future Greenwith Primary Students.

How will this fundraiser work?

We have partnered with online fundraising company, Go Raise It. Go Raise It specialise in working with schools to maximise their fundraising efforts. Collecting sponsorship online makes it super easy for everyone - no more door knocking, fundraisers can collect more donations from further afield (friends and family living overseas, work colleagues etc) and no need to worry about handling all that cash and bringing it into school.

How do I sign up to fundraise online?

Each student can sign up for their very own fundraising web page to send out to collect online sponsorship. Sponsorship can be collected from anyone, anywhere and sponsors can choose their own currency to donate in, if they wish.

We would love all fundraisers to have an online account set up for each child, linked to their class as prizes will be awarded for top individual and top class fundraisers. Online fundraising allows us to significantly reduce the administration overhead of collecting and dealing with cash and removes the need for families to bring cash to the office. Go Raise It Fundraising adhere to strict cyber-safe guidelines and this is built into our fundraising website. Prizes


