

Type your **BMGS student username** into this window, click 'Next', and then click on 'Forgot your password'. An email will be generated to your student email account so you can make up a password. You can then type your new password in the next window to Sign In.

The Online platform will initially open to the **"Dashboard"** page.

However, when accessing programs for your subject, click on the "**Libraries**" tab at the top of the page to see the below window. There are 3 main Libraries listed here.

Programs can be searched by either going to the relevant subject folder in one of the Libraries, or searching for a title/subject on the top right-hand side (see below – green arrow).




1. School Library : the programs in this Library include previous Clickview program updates, and staff program requests. The 2 subfolders here are for Primary and Secondary level, and are further divided into subject fields.

Primary Digital Video Library : programs for Primary School level viewers.

Secondary Digital Video Library : programs for Secondary School level viewers.

- 2. Clickview Primary Library : all programs supplied by Clickview for Primary School level as part of our subscription. Programs under this Library are also in subject folders.
- **3.** Clickview Secondary Library : all programs supplied by Clickview for Secondary School level as part of our subscription. Programs under this Library are also in subject folders.



If there are programs you wish to use on a repetitive basis, you can choose to copy them to your own **"Playlist"** – a tab found at the top of the page. Like having favourites, you can make up your own folders. This will save searching for them each time you need to view programs for homework. They can be deleted when you have finished with them.

Not all programs are available for all year groups. Depending on what year group you are in, you may only be able to view up to PG rated programs (Years 7-9).

Please be aware that staff will monitor your Playlists and Workspace.
