2022 College Captains

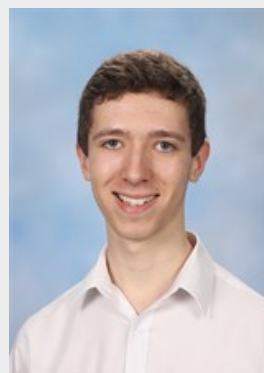
