

#3 Q & A Building Program 2024 - Updated: 28th June

We are pleased to inform our community that all electrical systems in the project have been isolated, and simple demolition has begun. During the school holidays, the building team will undertake significant demolition work in the office area. This timing will allow heavy machinery access to the school with minimal disruption to our students.

Project Length:

Onsite working days: 168 (excluding weekends & RDOs).

Key Dates and Milestones

Commencement Date: 17th June - Site set up
Stage 1A Handover 13th September - The first 10 weeks
Stage 1B Handover 22nd November - 20 weeks in total
Stage 2 Commences 25th November (*hopefully sooner
Stage 2 Handover 4th April, 2025

Stage 1 is split into two phases, A&B over a 20 week period commencing 17th June.

Stage 1A: 10 weeks - 17th June - 13th September

- Admin area relocated for 10 weeks i.e. no access to staffroom, Karen's office etc...
 Karen will share an office with Simon for 10 weeks.
- Staffroom moved to the storage room located off the old library, now Yr.5 room.
- First aid to the principal's office.
- MSL Intervention to resource area next to art room* (*Yr.2 room for Stage 1B)
- Entry to admin via the ramp closest to the church.
- Snapshot of additional works: Replace and repair all roofing. New compliant ramp to administration entry to enable better access for prams, disability and delivery access.
 Remove the wall between the staff room and old Board Room to create a better and more functional professional learning space.

 Due to supply issues some minor works to be completed at a later date e.g. operable walls in staffroom





Stage 1B: 20 weeks 17th June - 22nd November

 Refurbishment of current Year 5 to Year 2 classrooms (in total seven rooms), including corridor, roofing, new doorways, carpets, wall fabrics, external facade, and removal of breakout spaces and joinery.






Stage 2: Commencing: 25th November - April 4th, 2025

 Remaining three classrooms, current Year 1 & Preps, old library, soon-to-be STEM room and some minor works to the Yr.6 area.



Impact to playground:

The entire <u>blue</u> basketball court will be out of action for the program, including
the asphalt and flag pole area for a worksite (inc. sheds, toilets) and a safe
demolition zone.



Impact to, and entry points to the admin building and temporary learning spaces:

- Admin and front office via the ramp closest to the church. Main double doors inaccessible for 10 weeks.
- Yr.1, Yr.3, Yr.5 & Yr.6 enter via the 'eastern' breezeway next to the current Yr.1P room. Main breezeway from the blue court is not accessible.

- Prep M & W enter as per usual via the quiet area.
- Yr.4C & T enter via McKillop Hall northern door closest to the shipping container & uniform shop.
- Yr. 2 enter the art room via the playground.

Student Relocation Stage 1:

- Year 5s: Old Library AreaYear 4s: The McKillop Hall
- Year 3s: 6Ts classroom and access to the large breakout room situated between the two classrooms upstairs.
- Year 2: Art Room
- Year 6: Combined in 6M
