Rules for Senior School Examinations for Semester I, 2023

- Normal school rules apply during examinations. School uniform is to be worn correctly to all examinations.
- **All examinations will be held in the College HALL unless otherwise indicated on the exam timetable.**
- All examinations are of one and half-hours duration, with ten minutes reading time (Unless indicated otherwise on the timetable)
- Students are responsible for their own equipment-pens, pencils, rulers, and calculators, including spare batteries. All bags and other items including mobile phones must **NOT** be brought to the examination room; they must be left in student lockers.
- No borrowing of equipment will be permitted during examinations.
- Non-electronic dictionaries are permitted for use in English, EAL, Literature and LOTE **only**. This does **not** include English Language.
- **Students may not leave the examination until after the conclusion of writing time.**
- Students are advised to be at the examination centre fifteen minutes before the scheduled starting time. .
- All students in Years 9, 10 or 11 absent from an examination will be required to sit the examination at a later time. Students require a medical certificate if absent from an examination for the examination to be graded, otherwise an NA will be awarded on the report but feedback provided to the student by the teacher.
- Year 10 and 11 students are not required at school when they do not have a scheduled examination during the examination period. However, students are welcome to remain at school to study in the allocated rooms.
- Year 9 examinations are scheduled on Thursday 1st June and Friday 2nd June. Year 9 students are not required at school until 30 minutes before the commencement of their first examination.
- The GAT is scheduled for Thursday 15th June. Only students sitting the GAT are required at school on this day.
- Year 10 and 11 classes for Semester 1 finish on Friday 2nd June.
- Semester 2 commences for all students on Monday 19th June.
