There may be additional entry requirements (e.g. interview, portfolio, form) with different due dates for some courses. Please make sure you check requirements and dates for your course.

You must pay your course application processing fee on time to be considered for courses.

Supporting documents

Remember to submit all supporting documents before **Friday 15 September** to have them checked. When submitting hardcopies of your supporting documents to VTAC, please make sure you provide your full name and VTAC ID number and attach all relevant cover sheets (these can be downloaded from your VTAC online account). Any hardcopies of your supporting documents must be **received** by VTAC by **Friday 6 October**.

Impact statement

The impact statement is required for SEAS and scholarship applications for the following:

- Difficult circumstances (sexual assault, homelessness, domestic/family violence and formal out-of-home care)
- Disability or medical condition
- Disadvantaged financial background (in some cases)

You must complete your own impact statement. You must detail the situation you experienced and the impact it had on your education, including a timeline of the events (e.g. *My illness/disability impacted my studies as it was hard to concentrate in class; Flood damage to my home meant moving in with my extended family and the impact to my studies was that I had no study space and no internet access*).

Statement of support

The statement of support is required to support your personal impact statement for the following:

- Difficult circumstances
- Disability or medical condition
- Disadvantaged financial background (in some cases)

The statement of support must be completed by a responsible person who is knowledgeable about the relevant situation or circumstances (e.g. doctor, counsellor, medical specialist, psychologist, family accountant, lawyer). The statement of support must detail the situation and condition, a timeline of the events, and the impact it had on your education. This is not just verifying facts provided in the impact statement. A [fact sheet](#) is available for you to provide to your 'responsible person' to assist them in completing the statement of support.

Centrelink

Centrelink benefits include youth allowance, income tested health care card, and Family Tax Benefit A (FTB A).

1. If you receive Centrelink benefits in your name, provide your own Centrelink Customer Reference Number (CRN).
2. If your parent/guardian receives Centrelink benefits or the Family Tax Benefit A, provide a copy of their benefits to VTAC. Write your name and state the relationship of the person to you next to their name on the document.
3. **DO NOT** supply any documentation with a Tax File Number (TFN) to VTAC - all TFNs should be removed/hidden from any documentation prior to submission. Any documentation containing TFNs will be rejected.

CHECKLIST

- **Research the courses** you are interested in (and take note of prerequisite subjects and additional requirements)
- **Check your eligibility** for the [Monash Guarantee](#) (MG) and the [MG ATAR](#) for your preferred course
- **Do the [demo applications](#) on the VTAC website** so you have an idea of what you need to complete
- **Start planning and preparing any supporting documents** for your SEAS and scholarship applications – these need to be submitted before Friday 16 September for verification
- To **create a VTAC account** you'll need a **Unique Student Identifier (USI)** issued by the Australian Government. To create or retrieve a forgotten USI click [here](#)
- **Decide on your course preferences** (max. 8) and make sure you have the right course code for each one. Register for your VTAC account online and keep your ID and PIN safe (do not give to anyone)
- **Submit your VTAC course preference application**
- **Submit your VTAC scholarship and SEAS applications**
- Ensure you **submit all supporting documents before the due date**. Check that your documentation does not contain any tax file numbers (TFN). If they do, cross the TFNs out before submission.
- Make sure you're **prepared for any additional requirements** (e.g. interviews, auditions, portfolios)
- **Apply for on-campus accommodation** (if you're planning to move out of home)
- **Apply for a Tax File Number** – you will need this when you enrol for university
- [Study hard and do your best in the exams!](#)
- Once your ATAR is released, make use of the **Change of Preference** period. If you have questions, speak to your careers teacher, and attend Change of Preference expos and information sessions at universities

- **Follow the instructions in your course offer letter** and be sure to accept, reject, or defer your course offer
