



LASALLIAN YOUTH MINISTER (PART-TIME)

- Youth Ministry role based at Holy Trinity School, Inverell
- Rewarding part-time role, 16 hours a week
- Formation and accompaniment provided throughout the year

Lasallian Youth Ministers are employees of Lasallian Mission Council who are responsible for animating the faith life of their base school and the individual faith development of the young people they meet. This responsibility is carried out in accordance with the Lasallian tradition as well as other charisms of schools in our network. Their ministry is tailored to school culture and needs, with a focus on building relationships with students and providing a credible witness of faith. Lasallian Youth Ministers are part of the larger Young Lasallians team that also includes Lasallian Volunteers and La Salle Centre staff who supervise, support and accompany Youth Ministers. As a member of the Young Lasallians team, you will also be part of an international network and have the opportunity to participate in district wide events.

This position is based at Holy Trinity School, a co-educational K-10 school in Inverell. The school prides itself on being a community that encourages all students to value and respect themselves and others in their journey of faith, learning and life.

The Youth Minister will also have a dual line of supervision with support from a Young Lasallians Coordinator based in Sydney and a site supervisor in the school. This successful model has proven to empower Youth Ministers to carry on the legacy of access to Youth Ministry wisdom in our network and introduce new ideas.

Core Capabilities of Successful Candidates Include:

- Excellent interpersonal skills, with the ability to relate well to peers and youth
- Demonstrated core leadership attributes, especially when engaging youth, peers and teams
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Understanding of and commitment to the evangelising mission of the Catholic Church
- Administrative skills, such as attention to detail and time management
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Basic to intermediate multimedia skills.







Position Requirements:

- Relevant Working With Children Checks as well as other relevant state requirements
- First Aid Certification, or willingness to obtain such
- Current driver's licence
- High School Qualification
- Tertiary Qualifications (completed or ongoing) are preferred, especially in areas such as Theology/Religious Studies and Education.

Salary and Conditions:

School-based Youth Ministers are contracted for a period of 12 months at a salary classified as Level 3 in accordance with CCER standards, the hourly rate is \$27.95. An additional 152 hours are required to be worked during school holiday times, including professional development and support of regional and District-level Young Lasallians programs.
