## CLEANING

## SCHOOLS SHOULD ALSO CONSIDER:

- On the dedicated school bus services - **NO STUDENT WILL BE LEFT AT A BUS STOP**
- Students are requested to apply physical distancing on general public transport that are not dedicated school buses (trains, ferries, light rail, and general service busing).
- Students are requested to apply physical distancing where possible, particularly at interchange and layover areas on the public transport network.
- Schools are requested to remind students to wash hands or use sanitisers prior to departing school.
