

How to accept your Early Offers

1

Have you received an early offer? Well done, take a breath, and share the news, then follow the instructions in your offer letter

2

Is your offer conditional/provisional? You must complete your exams/meet any other conditions before it becomes unconditional

3

How do you accept your offer? Read the information carefully, as every uni is different and not all require you to formally accept. **Ask the uni** if you are unsure what to do (they're there to help)

4

What's the deadline? Make sure you accept your offer BEFORE the deadline or within the timeframe (e.g. 7 days after the offer)

5

Do you need to add it to your TISC preferences? If you've been told to, add the offer AFTER any other courses you prefer

6

Don't want the offer? Just allow it to lapse, or use it as a backup in case you change your mind

7

Accepting an offer isn't the same as enrolling - you DON'T need to enrol yet, and accepting an offer doesn't lock you in

8

Didn't receive an offer? Don't panic, you can still apply through TISC and receive an offer in the main round at the end of the year
