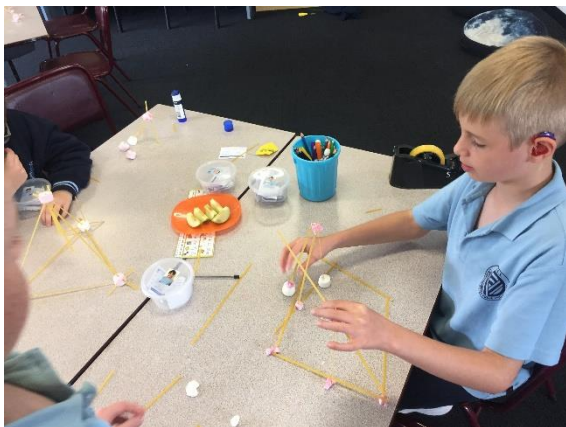


ENROLMENT

Assessments are required, involving a Psychologist and often a Speech Pathologist and Occupational Therapist. Our staff can organise all of these assessments.

All children who attend Vermont South Special School have an IQ between 50 and 70 and must be receiving 'PSD' funding from the Education Department. We will organise this process with you.
