Early Offer Applications Close 30th September 2021

Murdoch has introduced a Year 12 Early Offer Scheme as an entry pathway for those students graduating in 2021.

Applications are open now for students to apply directly through Murdoch for 2022 enrolment. The Safety Net offers a number of pathways for students, including using Year 11 ATAR subject results, Certificate IV and English Language Competency, Portfolio application, TLC110, Flexi-High, or direct application to a Murdoch Enabling program.

Students who meet eligibility requirements will be able to receive either a conditional offer to Murdoch commencing 2022.

**Please note Veterinary Science and Nursing is excluded from the Early Offer Scheme and students applying for these courses must still apply through TISC.*






NATIONAL SCIENCE WEEK SCINTILLATING SCIENCE QUIZ

As part of 2021's National Science Week celebrations, the Science Outreach team and Student Ambassadors hosted The Scintillating Science Quiz competition for Year 9 and 10 students. More than 3,500 students from 28 metropolitan and regional schools participated in the month-long event, answering questions on the science/mathematics school curriculum, science in the media, science in the wild and the science of food (the national theme for 2021).

Willetton Senior High School claimed first place as the metropolitan winner and will experience the Live & Explosive Science Show at their school in Term 4. Georgiana Molloy Anglican School claimed first place as the regional winner and have been awarded funding to travel to Murdoch University for a STEM excursion and on-campus performance of the Live & Explosive Science Show.
