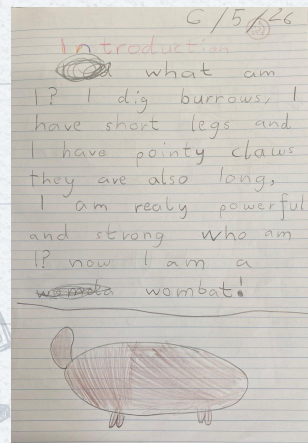
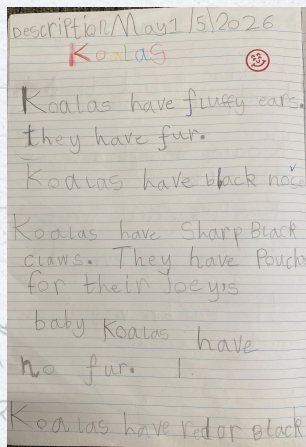




# WRITING

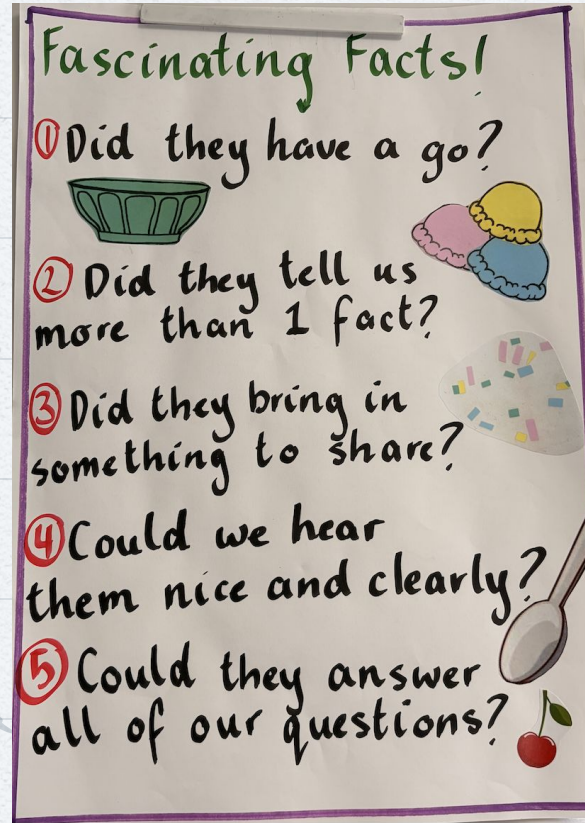
# SPECIAL PERSON MORNING
