Highlights:

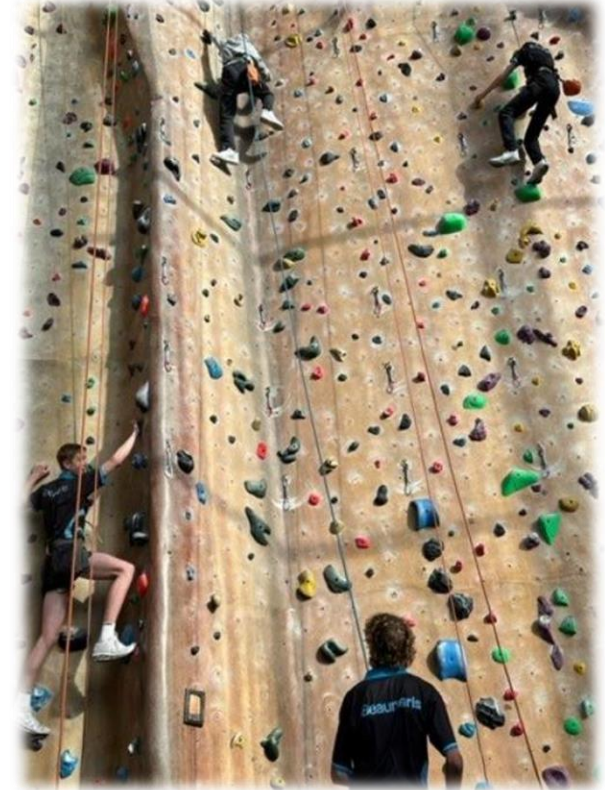
- Amazing scenery, dramatic coastlines, remote beaches, and picturesque campsites.

- Spend a day on country looking for bush tucker and visiting significant sites
- Explore the homeland as you collect and make your own bush medicine
- Visit the local school called Kenmore Park where the Traditional Owners teach
- Learn to cook kangaroo tail using traditional methods over fire

Day 5: Kings Canyon (Watarrka)

- Enjoy the spectacular 'Rim Walk' at Watarrka National Park

Day 6: Uluru and the Field of Lights

- After dark, travel to the Field of Light Uluru.

Day 7: Kata Tjuta and Return Home

- Make the most of your final morning and enjoy a sunrise over Uluru and Kata Tjuta.
