

LEADERSHIP & MANAGEMENT

- This year we have a student enrolment of 620 students. A growth of 29 students from 2025.
- We welcomed seven new staff members in 2026. The total number of staff in 2026 is 85.
- 2027 Prep Enrolments are now open. We will aim to offer 94 places for Prep in 2027. This year we have transitioned to the use of an online program to manage enrolments.
- We have had 9 school tour events for 2027 attended by over 110 people.
- In January we completed installation of internal glass walls and doors in the Rise Learning Space completing this project.
- Stage 4 building works are due to commence in June 2026.
- Sarah was invited to speak on a panel at the launch of the MACS Vision for Leadership at the State Library.
- Jess and I attended the VACPSP Leadership Conference at Lorne last week.

EDUCATION IN FAITH
