Traffic Light Prerequisites



Red Traffic Light

- Haven't met prerequisite (more than 5% of requirement)
- Maximum of 1 Red Light
- Academic progress meetings in Year 11 required

Amber Traffic Light

- Haven't met prerequisite (within 5% of requirement)
- Maximum of 2 Amber Lights
- Academic progress meetings in Year 11 required

Green Traffic Light

- Have met prerequisite with no conditions
- Unlimited selection of Green Light Subjects



Requirements of the WACE

- 1 Literacy and Numeracy Standard**

Prequalify via Year 9 NAPLAN (Achieve Band 8 or higher in Reading, Writing and Numeracy) or Pass OLNA (Reading, Writing and Numeracy)
- 2 Breadth and Depth**

Complete 20 Units in Year 11 & 12 (Minimum of 10 in Year 12, English is compulsory to study in Years 11 & 12, must have a List A and a List B course)
- 3 Achievement Standard**

Of the 20 completed units (as a minimum), students must achieve a C Grade in at least 14 units across Years 11 & 12 (with at least 6 C Grades in Year 12)
- 4 Unit Equivalents**

Students may substitute an ATAR or an APEx course with an Endorsed Programme or VET Qualification in Years 11 & 12

Student Academic Priorities

- Priority #1**

Achieve WACE at the end of Year 12 by meeting all four requirements
- Priority #2**

Maximise opportunities post-school (by striving for success in an ATAR or an APEx pathway)

Reasons to Pick a Subject

Wise Reasons

You have a passion for the subject

You have an ability in the subject

Prerequisites for tertiary study

Complementary course to one you are interested in

It is a compulsory subject (e.g., English or Literature or EALD)

You have a strategy for finding success in the subject

Unwise Reasons

Picking what subjects your friends are picking

Picking a subject where you think you'll know what teacher will teach it

You have heard that a particular subject has 'good scaling'

You're picking the subject because you have heard that you get a 'bonus'

You are unsure of what to pick so you have just picked at random
