2022 Non-Government Schools Census

The 2022 Non-Government Schools Census (the Census) will start in <u>SchoolsHUB</u> on Monday 1 August 2022.

Please ensure any staff completing the Census have read and understood this information.

Potential impacts of COVID-19 on the 2022 Census

As was the case in 2021, the Department of Education, Skills and Employment will closely monitor any effects COVID-19 has on schools in the lead-up to 2022 Census. If disruptions coincide with a significant portion of the Census Reference Period, the department will work with affected schools and make alternative arrangements for the Census where required.

Census privacy notice

A <u>privacy notice</u> explaining what we collect in Census and Special Circumstances Applications, why we collect it, and how we can use the data is available on SchoolsHUB. You must make the notice available to parents, guardians and staff.

Special Circumstances Applications (to include a student in the Census)

Students who did not attend during the Census Reference Period are not eligible for reporting in the Census. Where students did not attend during the Reference Period but otherwise meet the Census eligibility criteria, they may still qualify to be included in the Census due to their special circumstances. You must make a separate Special Circumstances Application for these students.

To best prepare Special Circumstances Applications, please ensure you have the following supporting documents:

- Evidence of the student's intent and the date they are returning to school.
- For long periods of absence, evidence showing how the school has engaged the student in education while they were away.
- If attending another school while absent, evidence of how the "away" school has reported (or not reported) the student in their Census.

All applications and supporting documents for Special Circumstances Applications <u>must</u> be submitted by **Friday**, **19 August 2022**.
