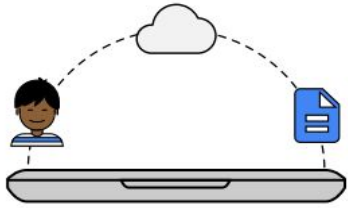

What is a Chromebook?

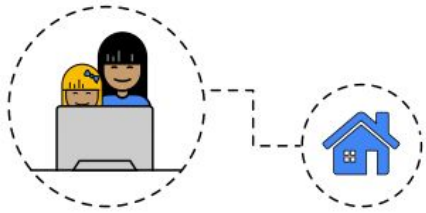
A simple yet powerful device with built-in accessibility and security features to deepen classroom connections and keep user information safe.

~ Google





- It's a laptop that runs on the Google Chrome operating system.
- The Chrome operating system is designed to work on the cloud, so that means everything—your files, your apps, even your desktop—lives online (not on your laptop) and is the same wherever you sign in. That means never misplacing your files or losing your work in progress (it's all right on the cloud).
- Tablet x Laptop - some can be utilised in this way, with newer models that include a world facing camera!
- Inbuilt virus protection
- Long battery life - can last a school day
- Easily accessible - log in with Google accounts - EDU accounts - these are managed by Oatlands.

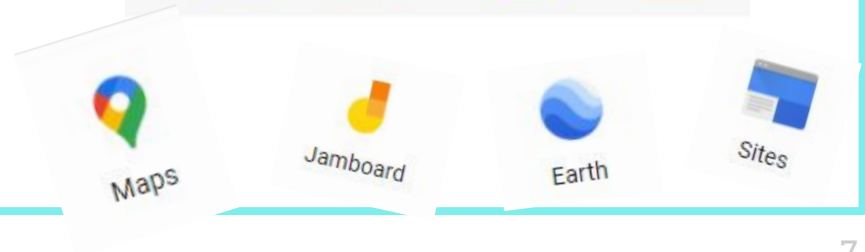

BYOC Program Guidelines and Expectations

Students are expected to:

- Use their device in an appropriate and educational manner that works in accordance with the Acceptable Use Agreement
- Not loan their device to another student or leave it unattended in such a place that is likely to be easily stolen or damaged
- Have their device charged at the beginning of each day. No chargers at school.
- Use age appropriate and educational apps and games
- Follow all teacher directions, including when to use the device
- Only use the device when under supervision of a teacher during class time
- Not use Google apps to communicate with other students about anything other than school based requirements.
- Engage in all online learning experiences and take on feedback from their teachers to enhance their learning.

Online Safety

It is integral to establish clear protocols and procedures when working in online spaces. These include:

- Reviewing and considering the safety and appropriateness of online tools and communities
- Developing a shared language of cybersafety and use digital technologies - at home and at school
- Modeling, sharing and exploring the positive potential of the internet and digital technologies
- Opening up the conversation with your child, where they can feel comfortable to ask for advice or share concerns when unsafe situations arise online.
