<p>RELIGION</p> 	<p>Throughout this unit, students will learn about the books of the Bible. They will learn to identify the ways God’s people are portrayed in the Old and New Testament stories. They will learn that the Bible has key messages: Love all, Treat Others how you would like to be treated, Respect everyone. Towards the end of term, students will reflect on encounters with the Word of God and describe how it is lived out in the community.</p>		
<p>LITERACY</p> 	<p>The students will continue to attend daily spelling sessions where they will revise previously taught sounds and irregular words. They will also learn to read, write and spell new sounds and irregular words. The grade 2s will be reviewing affixes they have learned, such as -ment, -er, -able and many others, to ensure they are confident with what they have previously looked at. The grade 1s will be focusing on saying and spelling the sounds: air, are and ear. In addition, they will also be reviewing affixes and sounds they have learnt this year.</p> <p>In Literacy, the students will be looking over vocabulary and key teachings from the Velveteen Rabbit. The students will be writing about the features of a narrative, practising their paraphrasing skills, and they will also be identifying main ideas within the text and different paragraphs. They will also continue to have opportunities to read aloud to a partner, practising their oral fluency and public speaking. All of these areas being covered are very useful and important for the students to practise and learn about.</p>		


<p>MATHS</p> <p>12345 67890</p>	<p>The Grade 2s will learn to recognise, compare and classify shapes, referencing the number of sides and using spatial terms such as 'opposite', 'parallel', 'curved' and 'straight'. They will also be learning to acquire data for categorical variables through surveys, observation, experiment and using digital tools. They will be sorting data into relevant categories and displaying data using lists and tables</p> <p>The Grade 1s will learn to make, compare and classify familiar shapes; recognise familiar shapes and objects in the environment and also identify the similarities and differences between them. In addition, they will be learning to compare directly and indirectly so they can order objects and events using attributes of length, mass, capacity and duration.</p>
<p>INQUIRY</p> 	<p>This unit will focus on our senses and also the environment around us. The students will be focusing on many areas and aspects of our world such as landscapes and landforms, the moon, the stars and constellations, and how daily weather can modify our behaviour.</p>
