Week 4 – Mon May 10th @ 4:30pm-5:30pm - Online.

Develop a plan for delivering an effective and engaging pitch, so you can win the support of community partners.

Week 5 – Mon May 17th @ 5pm-7pm – Live Event.

Live pitch with local leaders and community partners, where you will hope to win support to bring your idea to life.
