


Habitat:

Platypuses are native to Eastern Australia, Tasmania, Queensland, Victoria, and Western Australia! Platypuses dig long burrows in the riverbank with the entrance above the water to keep it well hidden! They hide in burrows so they can sleep for most of the day and shelter!



Life cycle:



Baby platypuses are born blind and hairless. They stay inside their burrow and drink milk from their mother! By 4 years old, they are ready to live on their own and hunt their little prey. Platypuses live for 20 years in captivity, and only 12 years in the wild!

- 2. Male platypuses are actually venomous!
- 3. They ooze milk from their mammary gland ducts!
- 4. Adult platypuses don't have teeth!
- 5. Their babies are called puggles!
- They weigh 2.4kg and their speed is 35k per hour




Glossary:


- 1. Mammary gland ducts: a place where you carry milk in.
