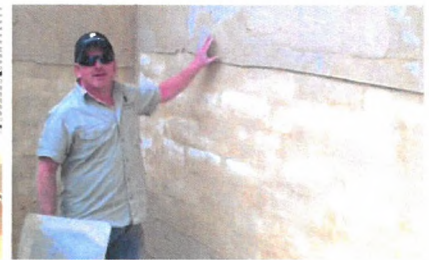




Try-A-Trade

A Construction Training Fund (CTF) initiative



North Metropolitan TAFE's Try-A-Trade program is targeted at high school students, to provide them with practical interactive trade experience in:

- Bricklaying
- Solid Plastering
- Wall & Floor Tiling
- Carpentry

The Try-A-Trade program runs for 3 days starting at 8:30am and finishing at 3:00pm. We can run these courses at our Clarkson or Balga campuses depending on your location.

Try-A-Trade is not available to a student currently enrolled in a Construction VETDSS qualification or already enrolled in any construction program for the following calendar year.

We require a minimum of 12 students and a maximum of 16 students to run a Try-A-Trade program.

Students will need to be wearing a pair of steel capped boots and have a pair of clear safety glass for use whilst attending the course.

Try-A-Trade is fully funded by the [Construction Training Fund](#) and aimed at generating student awareness and interest in construction careers.
