

Draft Walking and Cycling Plan

Background

City of Kingston is updating its Walking and Cycling Plan. This plan seeks to inform, develop and advance walking and cycling as a means of travel in the City of Kingston over the next five years.

In 2021, the City of Kingston asked the community about the changes Council could take to help make walking and cycling the preferred transport choice – particularly for short trips in the City. More than 200 community members responded posting over 900 pins on an interactive map to identify gaps, deficiencies and issues in the network. They also highlighted the priorities Council should focus on to improve walking and cycling in the City. This extensive feedback has been considered in drafting the City's Walking and Cycling Plan together with the legislative and policy context, upcoming major projects and other opportunities. Forty projects will now be taken forward over the next five years.

Have your say

Key to the success of the Plan is a joint effort with the many authorities responsible for delivering the network. This requires consultation, collaboration and coordination between Council departments, external stakeholders, and the wider community. We would like you to share your ideas on how the City of Kingston can improve the cycling and pedestrian experience in Kingston. Key stakeholders and community members are therefore invited to vote for their favourite projects to help prioritise the implementation of the 40 projects. We're also seeking feedback on our draft Walking and Cycling Plan 2023-2028. The draft Plan sets out a number of challenges, issues, considerations and includes other projects we're keen to advocate to external agencies for funding or implementation.
