This program also provides:

Program outcomes include:

- Students make informed career choices to access VET options like SBATs and Vet at school or transitioning to study TAFE NSW

Students will develop skills and knowledge in:

- Work health and safety procedures
- Infection control practices
- Safe manual handling and movement
- Using and maintaining hospital beds
- Understanding human anatomy
- · Communicating in a health setting
- Using medical terminology
- Conducting routine health assessments
- Basic First Aid

- A minimum
 15 years of age
- attending EPP school
- likely to benefit from exposure to a vocational pathway
