



Show and Tell - Term 3

As part of our Speaking and Listening program, Show and Tell will commence in week 2 and will run four days a week. This is a great opportunity for your child to become accustomed to speaking in front of an audience and we strongly encourage them to participate. We use the show and tell program to form part of our speaking and listening assessment. There will be specific topics for each week, as shown below. The day that your child will have show and tell is dependent on their house colour: **Monday - Coolibah (blue)**, **Tuesday - Mulga (green)**, **Wednesday - Waratah (red)** and **Thursday - Wattle (yellow)**.

For our Inquiry Unit this term, we are learning all about Family History and our Show & Tell presentations reflect this. During the term, we will be sending home sheets that we would love for you to help your child complete so they can share them with the class. Thanks in advance!

Week 2 20th July - 24th July	Bring in a photo of yourself as a baby to discuss and share with the class. Please note these photos will be displayed on a pin board as a level display. We can make a copy of the photo to display.
Week 3 27th - 31st July	Where did my family come from? Students are to bring in the location of where their ancestors came from - sheet to be provided.
Week 4 3rd - 7th August	Free choice - bring in one item to share and speak about with the class.
Week 5 10th - 14th August	Ask a member of your family what things were different when they were growing up compared with what it is like for you today. Parents please help your child complete the growing up now and growing up in the past sheet to share with the class.
Week 6 17th - 21st August	Free choice - bring in one item to share and speak about with the class.
Week 7 24th - 28th August	Book Week Celebration - students are to bring in their favourite book from home to share with the class.
Week 8 31st July - 4th September	Celebrations - students are to find out what celebrations/traditions are important to their families. Parents please help your child complete the Celebrations sheet for your child to share with the class.
Week 9 7th - 11th September	Free choice - bring in one item to share and speak about with the class.
Week 10 14th - 18th September	Students will be sharing and presenting their family history posters which they have been working on all term.
