- ❖ View, listen to and read simple texts about a Greek celebration e.g. OHI Day, Christmas and draw on key points of information
- ❖ Recite **tongue twisters** in order to further develop their oral language skills and present these at a future school assembly

EXCURSION TO KALYMNOS PASTRIES

On Thursday, 28th July, the Fisher Greek language students went on an excursion to Kalymnos Pastries (**Ζαχαροπλαστείο**). The purpose of the excursion was for the students to use the Greek language when placing an order and to consolidate their learning from the work covered in the topic: **Shops/Shopping**.

On arrival the students were greeted by George Diakomichalis who gave a brief talk about the business and its origins. They were then given a tour of the kitchen and shown how a cake is decorated with chocolate ganache.

Finally the students were given the opportunity to order a drink and sweet using their Greek language skills. The students really enjoyed the experience as well as their sweet treats.
