TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Tuition fees are a vital component of school income. Fees paid by parents are approximately 30% of total school income. Fees are primarily used to purchase classroom resources and to meet capital loan repayments along with other expenses incurred by the school.

You are encouraged to view the cost of educating your children as a high priority and part of Christian giving. A small proportion of all fees paid is provided to the Fund, to help assist those who are unable to pay full fees. Some families are able to contribute additional amounts directly into the Fund. The payment of school fees is a means, which through God's grace will allow the school to have adequate funds to meet the costs of running the school.

Assistance given by the Fund is limited and is intended to reduce the cost to some families of their tuition fees to a level that they can afford. Priority will be given to those families who have a demonstrated commitment to the School, regular payment of past tuition fees and the number of their children enrolled in the school.

Funds will be allocated at the discretion of the Mildura Christian College Scholarship Committee. Not all applications will receive assistance. If an offer of assistance is made, it will include the duration of that assistance. Some recipients may be asked to reapply regularly, others may be offered assistance for the duration of a student's primary years and/or secondary years. The amount of assistance and duration of that assistance will be determined by the Scholarship Committee on a case-by-case basis.

When your financial position improves or family situation changes, it is expected that you will advise the Fund, so that we can reassess the assistance provided and if necessary, reallocate the assistance to those in greater need.

Fee assistance will be provided within the following limits and conditions: -

1. An automatic payment schedule (Centrepay, Direct Debit, Sentral Pay, or similar) for the payment of school fees must be signed and remain in force for the assistance to remain valid.
2. Your repayments of tuition fees must always be current. Repayments which are outside your arrangements may result in the assistance being withdrawn.
3. Students receiving fee assistance are expected to maintain a high attendance rate and participate fully in school activities and events.
4. Students receiving fee assistance may have that assistance withdrawn if they fail to maintain an acceptable behaviour record.

COMMITMENT

I/We hereby make application for tuition fee assistance accepting the above terms and conditions. This application is submitted in good faith, and I/We solemnly declare conscientiously believing that all details contained herein to be true. In the event this application results in a reduction of the school fee payable I/We agree and accept that reduced fees are made possible in part through the support and commitment of the whole school community of which I/We am/are part. In response to, and as part of our commitment to that "partnership" arrangement, I/We give the following undertaking:

- To pay the agreed assessed fee via Westpac PayWay or Direct Debit system,
- To give the payment of school fees equal or higher priority for payment in recognition of the importance I/We place on the education of our child(ren),
- To advise the Fund when financial or family circumstances result in assistance being no longer required.
