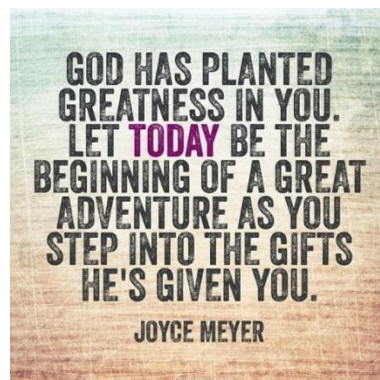

General Instructions

1. Students wear the normal John XXIII Day clothes to school on Friday August 7.
2. Bags with of camp clothes and gear may be kept in Mr Miller's office during the day if you wish.
3. Students collect bags immediately at the end of the school day and move to the bus.
You will need to take your school bag to the camp. We will be staying in the **Osprey dormitories**.
4. The Program timetable is attached. This has some flexibility other than mealtimes which are fixed by the caterers.
5. The camp will conclude at 2.30pm on Saturday and the bus should return to school by 3.00pm.

What To Bring:

- A. Camp clothes including Warm clothes
- B. Warm Pyjamas or windcheater and track pants to sleep in
- B. Cap or hat
- C. Tracksuit and gym shoes/joggers for exercise
- D. Water Bottle and torch
- E. File, writing pad, pen, mobile phone
- G. Toilet bags, sunscreen and any required medication or medical equipment eg epipen
- H. Enthusiasm, intelligence, attitude, respect, energy

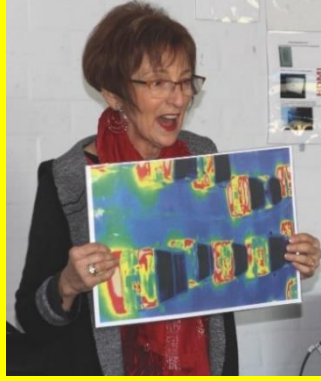
Note: Camp linen including sheets, pillows and blankets is provided. Students may bring blankets if you wish.



Special Instructions and rules:

1. The highest standard of cooperation is required at all times with all presenters and supervisors
2. Students may not leave the campsite at any time other than during the group exercise session on Saturday morning when we will be going down to the river at Pt Walter.
3. Students may not leave their sleeping dormitories after lights out except in an emergency or to visit the bathroom.
4. Boys may not enter girls rooms or vice versa during the camp.
5. Please see **Ms O'Connor** if you require First Aid.
6. Any damage must be reported immediately to Mr Miller
7. There must be adult supervision at times you are using any camp equipment
8. The camp pool is out of bounds during winter
9. Students must be punctual for all sessions and bring your file and pen
10. Mobile phones and ipads may be brought to the camp but phones must not be used except to make phone calls to parents prior to 8.30pm or after 6.30am in the morning.
