

Dear St. Peter's College,

We're starting major construction on the Western Port Highway project with a 24/7 closure of the Ballarto Road and Cranbourne-Frankston Road intersections.

We'll close Western Port Highway at the Ballarto Road and Cranbourne-Frankston Road intersections from **10pm Wednesday 16 March to 5am Monday 4 April**.

During this closure, our crews will be working 24/7 to prepare the intersections for the upgrade, allowing us to bring forward major construction and have the new intersections opened several months early.

Significant delays are expected, especially during peak travel periods.

When travelling through the area, [signed detours](#) will be in place to help drivers get where they need to be.

- Detours for local drivers will be in place via Potts Road or Pearcedale Road.
- Traffic travelling through the area will be encouraged to detour using South Gippsland Highway or Peninsula Link.

Delays of up to 30 minutes are expected. Drivers are being encouraged to plan their journey in advance and allow extra travel time.

We'll also need to close the two bus stops west of the Cranbourne-Frankston Road intersection as part of these works. Public transport users may use the bus stops located at Woodlands Road, Lyppards Road or Kelvin Grove instead. Stay up to date and plan your journey on the [PTV website](#).

Affected school bus routes will be detoured through the works area by traffic controllers. We'll work with schools to arrange new pick-up and drop-off points while works take place. Please contact us at the details below if bus routes for your school will be affected.

We understand that this closure will disrupt how members of the school community travel to and from school throughout these two and a half weeks, and we encourage you to share this information with them in advance of the closure.

We've attached a flyer that can be printed, displayed and shared as needed such as on your school website, newsletter and/or parent and student online portal.
