St Kilda Cemetery Fence Restoration project

Dear Community Partner,

Southern Metropolitan Cemeteries Trust is committed to supporting the community to honour and celebrate their loved ones and we understand memories are forever.

Given this, from February 2020, a restoration project will commence on the St Kilda Cemetery fence to preserve and maintain this iconic facade, at a cemetery steeped in important Victorian history.

The restoration project is anticipated to take 12 months to complete. During this time, there will be some disruption to cemetery visitation, local parking and surrounding roads.

The parking area and footpath along Alexandra Street, St Kilda, will be restricted during the restoration project to allow maintenance vehicle access, and to ensure the safety of the community during these important works. There will also be intermittent road restrictions on surrounding roads during the period, and the Hotham Street Bus Stop will be relocated.
